TARGET INTERNATIONAL SHIPPING
BILL OF LADING

1. Shipper (EXPORTER / SHIPPER)
2. Bill of Lading Number (BILL OF LADING)
3. Shipper's Address (SHIPPER'S ADDRESS)
4. Consignee (CONSIGNEE TO)
5. Forwarding Agent (FORWARDING AGENT)
6. Point of Origin (POINT (STATE) OF ORIGIN OR FTZ NUMBER)
7. Notify Party (NOTIFY PARTY / INTERMEDIATE CONSIGNEE)
8. Destination Agent (DESTINATION AGENT)
9. Marks and Numbers (MARKS AND NUMBERS)
10. No. of Pkgs (NO. OF PKGS)
11. Description of Packages and Goods (DESCRIPTION OF PACKAGES AND GOODS)
12. Gross Weight (GROSS WEIGHT)
13. Measurement (MEASUREMENT)
14. Declared Value (DECLARED VALUE)

1. Shipper

State the full name and address (including country) of the shipper.

2. Bill of Lading Number

Enter number used to identify this shipment.

3. Export References

Enter reference information such as Purchase Order #, Invoice #'s, etc....

4. Consigned to

Enter the recipient's information, such as company or individual name, street address, city, state and zip code.

5. Forwarding Agent

Enter the forwarding agent's information, such as company or individual name, street address, city, state and zip code. Only used when a middle person is used regarding a shipment.

6. Point (State) of Origin or FTZ Number

Enter the location the shipment originates from.

7. Notify Party / Intermediate Consignee

Enter the notify party's or intermediate consignee (Overseas broker) information, such as company or individual name, street address, city, state and zip code. Only used when a middle person is involved with the shipment.

8. Destination Agent

Enter the information of the final party to notify, such as company or individual name, street address, city, state and zip code.

9. Marks and Numbers

Enter any distinguishing marks or numbers that can be used as identifiers, such as part number, etc.

10. No. of Pkgs

Enter the number of packages that are associated with the previously entered marks and numbers.

11. Description of Packages and Goods

Enter a physical description of what is being shipped.

12. Gross Weight

Enter the weight of the shipment including weight of shipping materials/

13. Measurement

Enter the length, width and height or volume of the item(s) being shipped.

14. Declared Value

Enter the dollar amount associated with the worth of the shipment.
